MYRTLE BEACH

You may think a 60-mile string of wide sandy beaches and more than a hundred golf courses would be enough to lure vacationers to Myrtle Beach, but this popular coastal South Carolina city offers even more to enjoy. Also known as the Grand Strand, the Myrtle Beach area is a fantasy land of attractions—from a national park to Dolly Parton's Dixie Stampede Dinner and Show to a 3-in-1 nightclub. The beach is the biggest attraction, of course, for its swimming, boating, fishing and sunbathing. In the summer, the population exceeds 500,000 people! The off-season brings smaller crowds, but no shortage of fun. With restaurants galore, a rocking nightlife and accommodations that run the gamut from high-rise beachfront hotels to campgrounds with indoor swimming pools, Myrtle Beach—named for the city's signature myrtle tree—is an all-around, year-round getaway.

How to Get Around



"Staying patient is the key to managing **traffic jams** in Myrtle Beach. Also, it helps to avoid certain areas during certain times of day. Don't head south on the Route 17 bypass between the hours of 4:00p.m. and 6:00p.m., as it can be a nightmare with local residents heading home from work."—TripAdvisor Member

"The Myrtle Beach area is a bit too long for most to comfortably walk (and it can be dangerous crossing the street). There is a local **taxi** service, although they are not nearly as cost effective as the **Lymo buses**."—TripAdvisor Member
